HOUSING DETAILS

Campus: OPTION B If you decide to live on campus at Trinity you will be housed in apartments on campus. Some of the college buildings date back to the 19th century so there is plenty of atmosphere! You will be housed with other students attending the summer school and will be able to take advantage of being located right in the heart of the city and close to classrooms!

Campus accommodation for the summer school is in modern 4/5 roomed apartments and students will each have their own bedroom. This housing arrangement includes continental breakfast but each apartment has kitchen facilities. There are also student dining facilities available on campus during the day and numerous cheap places to eat close to campus.

Homestay: OPTION A With this option you will have the chance to live with an Irish family during the period you will be in Dublin and attending the summer school at Trinity. The host families for the programme live in areas that are convenient by bus or local rail/tram services to Trinity College and all your transport costs will be covered by your travel pass. All meals (breakfast, packed lunch and dinner) are included so you will only be responsible for your food when travelling at weekends and during the week in Belfast.

In many cases there will be two students staying with each family so please let us know if there is someone with whom you would like to be housed. Equally if you have any dietary restrictions /preferences or any allergies (animals, food etc.) please do let us know in advance so that we can try our best to accommodate your requests.

SUMMER SCHOOL FLIGHT

The **USIT** / Trinity Summer School in Irish Studies does not offer a designated flight option to Dublin. However, we do recommend TravelCUTS, our US travel partner, for good fares and service.
